- If you are teaching children under 18 years old, ensure that there is another employee or approved adult volunteer present in the classroom
- Utilize positive approaches in classroom management and encourage an atmosphere of community and respect
- Report concerns about student/class progress or well-being, curriculum, safety, or other class issues promptly to your supervisor, the Assistant Director, or the Executive Director
- Participate in ongoing professional development in the field
